The family has chosen to honor Brian's wishes for cremation. Arab Heritage Memorial Chapel is assisting with arrangements.

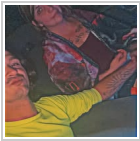

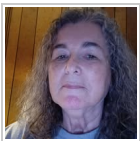
