Mr. Cade Laney, age 36, of Morgan City, passed away on Saturday, March 14, 2020 at Marshall Medical Center North in Arab, Alabama.

Mr. Laney was born in Huntsville, Alabama on November 26, 1983. After graduating from Arab High School, he joined the Marshall County Sheriff's Office as a Deputy/ Dispatcher. Cade was a U.S. Air Force Veteran, serving his country in the Iraq War. After returning home, he was employed by SCI – Sanmina as a Quality Control Technician. Cade had many accomplishments throughout his life. His high school faculty selected him as Mr. Arab High School in 2002. He competed in track and field and was ranked 5th in the 2002 state decathlon. He was selected to the all-county football team and was a state ranked gymnast in his earlier years. He was a member of Sweet Home Baptist Church.

Cade is survived by his wife, Mary Beth Laney, mother, Cheri Wray Laney, father, Donald Wayne Laney and two brothers, Joshua Laney (Amber) and Cory Laney (Laura), and a host of other family and friends.

A visitation will be held from 11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at the Brindlee Mountain Chapel at Morgan City. Funeral services will follow the visitation at 2:00 p.m.

Burial will be at Mount Olive Cemetery at Morgan City with Randy Blakely officiating and a eulogy by his brother Josh Laney.

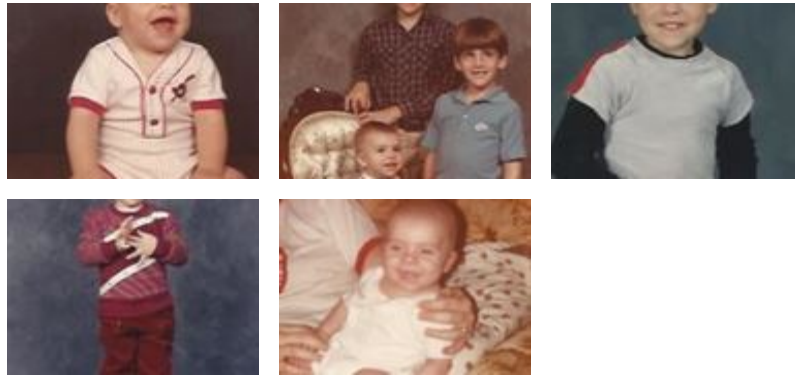
