Carl B. "Pete" Cox, Jr., 75 of Arab died Sunday, May 24, 2015 at his residence.

Mr. Cox was born January 30, 1940 in Marshall County, the son of Carl B. Sr. and Ella Fair Green Cox. He was a graduate of Arab High School, Class of 1958 and served in the Alabama National Guards.
