Charles Curtis "Chuck" Chamblee, Jr. passed away on Friday, August 8, 2024 at his residence in Arab, Alabama. Chuck was born July 1, 1961 in Marshall County, Alabama, the son of Charles Curtis Chamblee, Sr. and Jo Ann Nolen Pittman. He and Brenda Pierce Chamblee were married for over 30 years. Chuck worked as a Program Engineer for TYDO, a division of the FBI. He was of the Baptist faith and a member of Eastside Baptist Church.

Chuck loved computers and technology. He was tech savy and considered to be a net working genius. 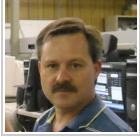
