United States Army, Vietnam Veteran

Danny F. Tidmore, 66 of Arab died Friday, April 17, 2015 in Marshall Medical Center North, E. R.

Mr. Tidmore was born Friday May 21, 1948 in Marshall County, the son of Robert R. Tidmore and Bertha M. Gibbs Tidmore. He was a carpenter and farmer and served with Honor and Courage in the United States Army during the Vietnam War from March 13, 1968 to March 5, 1970 receiving the rank of Sergeant; he transferred to the U. S. Army Reserve and was Honorably Discharged March 12, 1974.

He was married to the former, Marta Leticia Ramirez October 8, 2009. He was a member of the Liberty Church in Arab and enjoyed gardening, being with his family and working outdoors.
