



## Esther Pauline Bright Light

March 3, 1931 - March 7, 2013

Esther Pauline Bright Light, 82 of the Hulaco area Joppa died Thursday, March 7, 2013 at her residence.

Mrs. Light was born at home on Sand Mountain, March 3, 1931 the daughter of the late Melvin Leroy Bright and Mary Frances Morrow Bright. The family later moved to Brown's Valley and then to the Hog Jaw Community and except for a year living in Ohio as a newlywed, Pauline spent most of her life living in the Hulaco Community.

Pauline went to grammar school at Rice School House, early high school at Ryan High School and graduated from Arab High School in 1949. It was at Ryan High School that she met her future husband, Stancel Light, who preceded her in death January 10, 1999.
