January 30, 1934 - July 20, 2015

Everett D. Stidger, 81 of Lacey's Spring died Monday, July 20, 2015 in Summerford Nursing Home, Falkville, Alabama.

Mr. Stidger was born January 30, 1934 the son of Eldon and Imogene Stidger of Lacey's Spring and was a lifelong resident of that community. Everett graduated from Cotaco High School, received his Bachelor's degree from Florence State Teacher's College (now UNA) and his Master's degree from the University of Montevallo. He taught in the Huntsville City School system for 40 years, retiring in June of 1998. He was also a Master Mason, Member of Union Grove Lodge # 320 for over 50 years.

He is survived by his wife: Sue Stidger and a daughter: Kari Stidger both of Lacey's Spring; a brother-in-law: J. L. Smallwood, Jr. (Marion) of Robbinsville, North Carolina; preceded in death by his parents: Eldon and Imogene Stidger and two brothers: Ethridge and Elbert Stidger.
