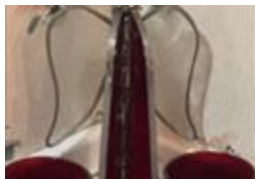
# Tribute Wall

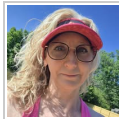
