



## Helen Snow

November 2, 1927 - January 13, 2015

Helen Iona Brown Snow, 87 of Arab died Tuesday, January 13, 2015 at her residence.

Mrs. Snow was born November 2, 1927 in Elmore County, the daughter of Harless Alexander Brown and Evie Rosalee Burgett Brown. She was a graduate of Douglas High School, Class of 1947 and went on to pursue a teaching carrier at Florence State Teachers College (UNA), graduating with the Class of 1953. She was a member of Concord Church, near Douglas, a former resident of Montana, but has called Arab her home since 1971, retiring after 30 years teaching from the Arab City School System.

She is survived by two daughters and a son-in-law: Deborah and Russell Messer of Guntersville and Pamela Neale of Arab; three grandchildren and spouses: Chris (Heather) Messer, Lauren (Andrew) Ridgeway and Blake Neale; a great grandchild: Landon Messer; a brother: H. 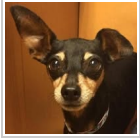
