



## Mr. Henry "Hank" E. Linsky Jr.

April 18, 1945 - April 23, 2023

On April 23rd, Henry ("Hank") Eugene Linsky Jr, beloved husband, father, and grandfather passed away at the Hospice Family Care at Redstone Village at the age of 78 years young.

Born in Brooklyn, NY on April 18th, 1945, Hank moved to Arab, AL as a child where he graduated from Arab High School in 1963. After serving as a medic in the Air Force during the Vietnam Era, Hank chose a career as a registered nurse which lasted a span of over 35 years. His final 25 years were spent as a civilian nurse for the US Army which included a 3-year stint in Germany. His love and compassion for others gained him the respect of patients and coworkers alike and he was presented the Superior Civilian Service award in recognition of meritorious service while assigned to Fox Army Health Center.

In January of 1965, Hank met his sweetheart, Rose Sharon Towery, and after a whirlwind romance, they married on August of the same year. Hank and Sharon went on to have two children, Marlene and Heather.

In 2007, Hank retired and went on to pursue his other passions including gardening, fishing, and spending time with his grandchildren. His steadfast Christian faith inspired him to serve in numerous ministries within the church throughout his lifetime and his faith was a source of strength and encouragement to those who knew him.

Hank is predeceased by his mother, Mary Nunnelley Linsky, and his father, Henry Linsky Sr. He is survived by his wife, daughters, and sisters Mary Nell (Dan) Smalley, Trisha (Roger) Stanley, and Kathy (Mack) Reed, as well as his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
