Henry Dewey Steadham, age 84, went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Sunday 22 February 2015. Henry attended Valley Fellowship Church and Church of the Highlands. He was a Korean War Veteran and an avid gardener who found peace in the garden and in the woods. He loved working with the Casa Angelina orphanage in Guatemala and being with his friends in the R.O.M.E.O. Club. He was also a member of the Union Hill State Champion Basketball team of 1950, the first team in Morgan County to have that honor and is commemorated on a plaque at the school.

Henry leaves behind his wife of 25 years, Mrs. Frances S. Steadham. He is preceded in death by one brother, Robert Dewitt Steadham and three sisters, Dorothy Monroe, Dovie McKee and Zelphia Barber.
