



Mr. Isaac Wenton Hall

July 20, 1932 - February 13, 2023

Mr. Isaac Wenton Hall, of the Ruth community of Arab, Alabama, passed away at Shepherd's Cove Hospice on Monday, February 13, 2023 at the age of 90.

Mr. Hall was born on July 20, 1932 to Joseph Alexander "Alec" Hall and Grace Beatrice Atwell Hall. He was a retired U.S. Army Sergeant with over 20 yrs service and was drafted and served during the Korean War. He was married to Ruby Loreen Slifer and was a member of the Arab First Baptist Church. Isaac's nickname was Ike, and in addition to his Army career, Ike served as an Instructor for the Civil Service for 10 years while volunteering for the Madison County Police Department. After he retired from teaching cadets, he served 10 additional years as a Police officer. He enjoyed hunting when he was younger and just loved the mountains of Virginia. He was very proud of his military and civil service career and the many things he accomplished. He often talked about all the places he served and what he accomplished along the way (i.e. finishing his education with a Master's degree in Business and Bachelor's in Law).

Mr. Hall leaves memories behind to be cherished by his wife, Ruby Hall. He was also married twice prior to Shirly Pinkerton and his first wife Lillian Thomas. He had three children, sons; David Hall (Debbie) and Dwayne Hall (Ellen); and daughter, Susan Hall; adopted son, Caleb Hall. Isaac had several step-children from his marriages including sons; David Miller (Tonya), Kevin Edward Miller, William Russel Snook, daughters; Christina Miller, Tammie

Raye Snook and Amber Michelle Snook. Isaac is also survived by his brother, David Jesse Hall; half-sister, Linda Pasley, and a host of grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Mr. Hall is preceded in death by his parents; Joseph Alexander Hall and Grace Virginia Atwell Hall; adopted daughter, Shirley Ann Hall; sisters, Viola Hall Dunford and Olivette Hall Darnell; half-sister; Elizabeth June Stone Adams; and brother, Daniel R. Hall.
