August 15, 1947 - September 27, 2023

Mr. James Carson Barrett, age 76, of Union Grove, Alabama passed away Wednesday, September 27, 2023 at his home. James was born in Chicago, Illinois on August 15, 1947, son of Johnny Clarence Barrett and Dorothy Williams Barrett. His family moved from Miami, Florida to Union Grove, Alabama in the 1950's where he resided for the remainder of his life. James was married to Sarah Sue Huskey Barrett, who passed away August 2013.
