Jeffery Phillip Mims (Phillip) was born in Guntersville on June 11, 1985 to Jeff and Clara Mims. He died February 12, 2022, at the home he shared with his parents in Union Grove. The cause of his sudden death, while being investigated, follows a year's long struggle with addictions.

He is preceded in death by his grandparents, Ken and Julia Mims, and Buddy and Mary Alice Reno. Phillip is survived by his parents, two children Audrey and Tyler with their mother Kaitlen Pruett, his sisters Christy Graves (Shawn), LeAnn McLain (Mark), Tiffany Cunningham, Breanna Harvell (Robert), and Michaela McCurry, and his brothers Aaron Mims, and Grant Mims (Haley); thirty-two cousins and fourteen niece and nephews.

Phillip was a member of the Beth Haven Baptist Church in Crossville, and the Life Gate Baptist Church in Arab. His occupation the last several years was in lawn care, primarily for Yarbrough's Lawncare Inc. He spent nearly all of his spare time helping take care of his parents' home and gardens, and helping their neighbors; he could fix most anything.
