"Jimmy" James William Edwards, of the Morgan City community of Lacey's Spring, Alabama, passed away midday Saturday, March 29, 2025 at Maury Regional Hospital in Columbia, Tennessee. Jimmy was born March 14, 1932, and just recently celebrated his 93rd birthday. Jimmy was one of eight children born in Morgan County, AL to Welmer Elijah Edwards and Winnie Rosa Kidd Edwards. Having been born amid the Great Depression, spending his childhood years throughout WWII and his young adulthood during the Vietnam conflict, experiencing the space race, the technology revolution, and everything in between are all events we read about in history books but he experienced firsthand.
