



Ken Driskill

December 18, 1933 - July 13, 2014

Kenneth Ray "Ken" Driskill, a former Arab businessman, church and civic leader, died Sunday, July 13, 2014 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 80 years old.

Ken was born in Dawson, Alabama in 1933, the son of Charlie and Pearle Driskill. He was preceded in death by his parents and brothers: Herman, Harvel, Barney, C. B. Jr. and Verlon and sisters: Clarice Driskill, Forestine Loyd and Bernice Rogers.

He married Judith Annette Gann of Kilpatrick, Alabama and is survived by his wife, son: Greg (Lisa) Driskill, daughter: Dawn (Jeff) Morgan and grandsons: Will Morgan, Hudson Driskill and Harrison Driskill.

A graduate of Crossville High School in 1956, he attended the University of Tennessee-Chattanooga on a football scholarship. He served in the United States Air Force and was stationed in the Philippines during the Korean War. He and his wife Judi owned and operated Driskill Insurance Agency in Arab for over 30 years.

Ken served on several civic and business boards including Regions Bank, Arab Kiwanis Club and Arab Quarterback Club. He was recognized as Outstanding Kiwanis Club member of the year, Cotton States Agent of the

year and Outstanding Businessman of the year by the Arab Chamber of Commerce. He was a member of the Arab Church of Christ and served as an elder there for 37 years.

Brother Ken Tyler and close friend Frank Smith will conduct Ken's funeral service at 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 15, 2014 at the Arab Church of Christ. Burial will be in the Arab Memorial Cemetery, Arab Heritage Memorial Chapel, directing.
