Kenneth (Kenny) Ray Dix went home to be with his Lord on September 12, 2024. Kenny was born July 21, 1931 near Beedeville, Arkansas. He was one of nine children born to his parents, Alfred Spencer Dix and Lula Goss Dix. Kenny graduated from Beedeville High School in 1951. He served his country in the United States Air Force from 1951 to 1955. After his military service, he earned a Title 1 certificate to teach vocational education from Alabama A&M. Kenny taught Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (HVAC) at A.P. Brewer Area Vocational Center at A.P. Brewer High School. Kenny was a faithful member of Bethlehem Baptist Church in Lacey's Spring.

Kenny was preceded in death by his parents, 8 siblings, his daughter, Lisa Dix, a grandson, Nicholas Green and his son-in-law George Kunkle.
