Larry M. Crawford, of Arab died Wednesday, November 18, 2015 at his residence.

Mr. Crawford was born February 18, 1941 in Jackson County, the son of Lloyd R. and Margaret A. Holland Crawford. He was married 51 years to the former Sandra Poole and has called Arab his home since 1963, where he was a member of the Arab First Baptist Church.

He was a graduate of Howard College, now Samford College, where he received his degree in pharmacy. During his career as a pharmacist, he was owner/operator of Hospital Pharmacy from 1964 to 1994, a former member and president of the Arab City School Board, the Marshall County Auburn Club and also a former member of the Arab Lions Club. He was on the Arab City Council from 2004 to 2008 and was a member of the Arab Masonic Lodge 663 and an avid Auburn football fan.

He is survived by his wife: Sandra Crawford; a son and daughter-in-law: Jason R. and Karen Crawford; a daughter: Dr. Cale Crawford Ebert; two granddaughters: Emily Thrasher and Marla Ebert and two brothers and a sister-in-law: Steve and Debbie Crawford and Tom Ed Crawford.
