He was a lifelong resident of the Arab community, a member of the New Canaan Baptist Church, a high school graduate and had earned his Associates Degree. His love of the ocean led him to enlist in the US Navy in 1967 at the age of 19. He was a Vietnam Veteran and served on the battleship USS Rowan (DD-782). He was deployed three (3) times to Vietnam in order to aid and give fire support to the US troops during the time of conflict. Larry was a workaholic and loved to be outside. He grew up working on the family cattle farm, riding his motorcycle, playing and coaching baseball. His love of the ocean continued to draw his interest which eventually led him to his hobby of fishing, especially deep sea fishing. He was employed as a Fabrication Manager for International Fire

Protection in Huntsville, AL. After his retirement Larry became interested in painting by watching the legendary Bob Ross on PBS. He decided to try his hand at the skill of painting and became an accomplished artist. Most everyone he knew and loved was given an original "painting by Larry." He and Virginia Ann Voyles Johnson have shared 53 years of marriage and are proud parents of three children.

Larry lived a beautiful and meaningful life and will be greatly missed. 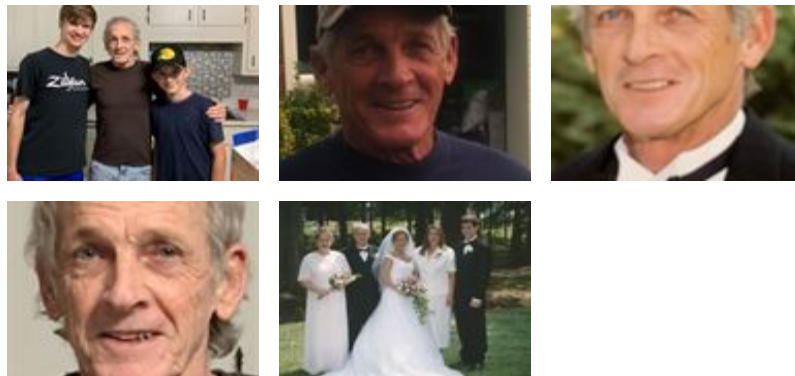

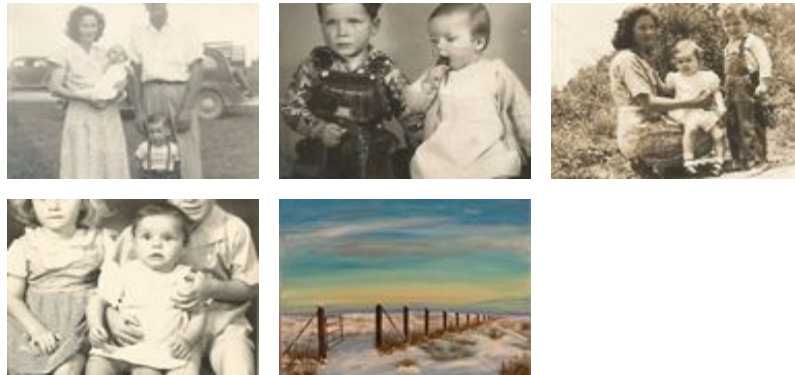
