



## Marlin L. Clemons

December 11, 1939 - September 21, 2015

Marlin L. Clemons, 75 of Arab died Monday, September 21, 2015 in Huntsville Hospital.

Mr. Clemons was born December 11, 1939 in Marshall County, the son of Dallas and Cora Forrester Clemons. He was a lifetime resident of Arab, a graduate of Arab High School, Class of 1958, and a member of Arab First Baptist Church. He retired from Redstone Arsenal after 34 years as an Information Technology Specialist.
