Mary Frances “Fran” Green Smith, 82 of Arab, Alabama died Wednesday September 7, 2016 at her residence.

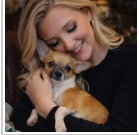

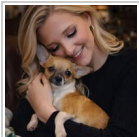
