Myra Doris Gregory, 87 of Union Grove, the Mountain View Community died Monday, November 2, 2015.

Mrs. Gregory, a retired school teacher, devoted wife, mother and Christian was born February 11, 1928 in Marshall County, the daughter of Major E. and Sallie Allen Mabrey. She was married to Hobert Gregory for 38 years who preceded her in death in 1991. She has called the Mountain View Community her home until the last five years as she has lived at Redstone Village Assisted Living.
