Olivie Saylor, 92 of Arab died Tuesday, January 15, 2013 in Golden Living Center of Arab.

Mrs. Saylor, born on April 28, 1920, was the youngest and only remaining sibling of 16. The daughter of F. M. and Leola Elizabeth Hunt Herring Head, she grew up in the Eddy community.

On February 26, 1937, she married Dewitt Saylor. They were married for 72 years at the time of his death in April of 2009. On February 14, 2009 an article about their marriage appeared in the Arab Tribune honoring them as the couple in Arab that had been married the longest.

Survivors include her daughter: Vondaleen Saylor Hammond of Arab; and her grandchildren: Lenny and Sherry Hammond VanZandt of Guntersville, Eric and Tiffany Hammond of Arab and Rodney and and Patty Hammond of Gulf Breeze, Florida.
