



## "Sam" Tolbert Hugh Coker

January 19, 1930 - December 24, 2025

Mr. "Sam" Tolbert Hugh Coker, a beloved member of the Arab community, passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday evening, December 24, 2025, at the age of 95. Born on January 19, 1930, in Marshall County, Alabama, Sam was the son of John Robert Coker and Amy Avis Lawler Coker. He graduated from high school and went on to earn an associate's degree. Sam was a devoted member of Shoal Creek Baptist Church throughout his life. He was preceded in death by his cherished wife, Lucy Lorene Hood Coker, who passed away on May 21, 2018.

Sam was widely known as a successful businessman in Arab, where he owned and operated Coker Tractor Company, a John Deere dealership, for more than 65 years. When not dedicating his time to his business, Sam enjoyed tending to his garden and watching his favorite ball teams on TV, especially enjoying the sport teams of the University of Alabama.

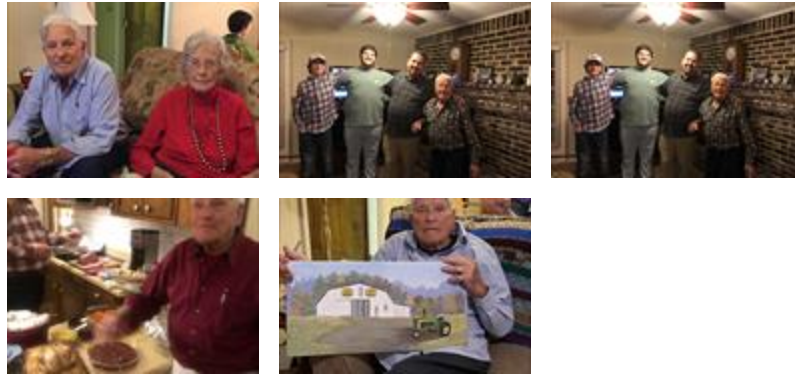
