



## Mrs Sarah "Sue" Reynolds

Mrs. Sarah Sue Reynolds, of the Joppa Community in Arab, Alabama, passed away at Brookwood Medical Center in Birmingham, Alabama on Tuesday, January 24, 2023 at the age of 88.

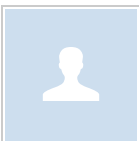
