Scott Layne King, 45 of Covington, Georgia, formerly of Arab died Tuesday June 3, 2014 in Georgia.

Scott was a member of the First Baptist Church in Covington and a 1986 graduate of Heritage High School, in Conyers. After graduating from Heritage he continued his education at DeKalb Technical College and later graduated from Florida Baptist Theological College with his degree in Christian education.

He worked for a printing company as a graphic artist, was an elementary school teacher and a youth minister. His hard work is what enabled him to pay his own way through college.
