Ms. Vera "Ozell" Wray Green, age 99, of the Mobbs School Community of Union Grove, Alabama passed away Wednesday, March 29, 2023 at her residence. She was born November 12, 1923 in Hartselle, Alabama. Her parents were Benjamin Franklin Wray and Georgie Olevia Dutton Wray. She was married to Hoyt Boyd "Tobe" Green who passed away in 1976. Ms. Green was a charter member of the North Parkway Church of Christ.

Ms. Green passed away just eight months short of her 100th birthday. The events she lived through and experiences she had we have only heard of and/or read about. 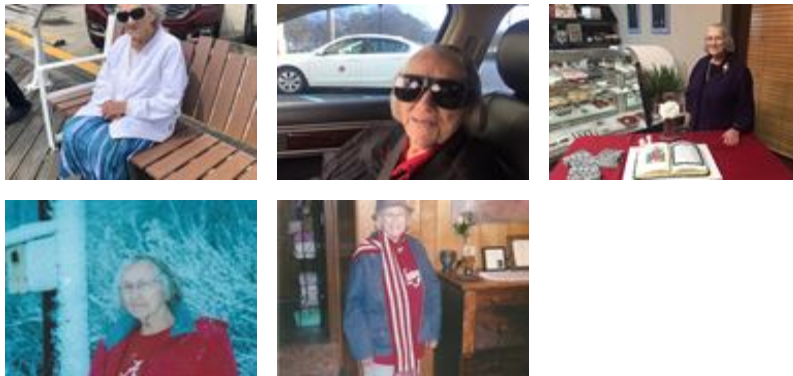
